

# Guam gymnasts win 17 medals

Guam gymnasts brought back 17 medals from the 40th Annual Aloha Gymfest meet in Kailua, Hawaii, held Jan. 14-17 — seven gold, six silver and four bronze.

Island Twisters Gymnastics' Lillian McClellan, 9, took first in the all-around in her age division, as well as the all-around of all age groups in the Level 4 competition.

Isabella Kebreau and Qaydenz Montgomery competed as Level 7 gymnasts this year, three levels higher than what they competed as last year.

Kebreau, 11, placed first on the floor, third in the all-around and fourth on vault and beam in the Child B

Division.

Montgomery was second in the floor and fourth in the vault in the Junior A competition.

Eileen Mamczarz, 12, competed as a Level 5 gymnast. She placed fourth on bars, beam, floor and the all-around in the Junior A Division.

Janine Miller, 12, Phaedra Redman, 9, and Elizabeth Mamczarz, 10, competed as Level 4 competitors in their very first gymnastics meet.

Miller was first on floor, second on vault, third on beam and second in all-around in the Junior B division.



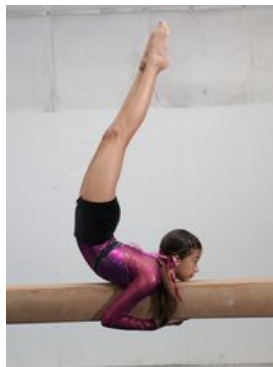

Redman was first on bars, third on beam, third on floor and second in the all-around in the Child B Division.

Mamczarz also competed in the Child B division, taking second on vault, fourth on bars and fourth in the all-around.

There were 500 gymnasts from 37 teams and seven countries competing at the Aloha Gymfest.
